

Highlighted Key Words in Psalm 119

The following table represents the number of times each of the words are found in Ps. 119. Each word is highlighted in the text below in order to give a visual representation of the context of the psalm. Psalms 119 is the longest chapter in the Bible and well represents the attitude the psalmist had towards the instructions that God gave to His people from an Old Testament perspective. The title "LORD" was also replaced with the personal name of God (Yahweh) which is from what is called the tetragrammaton —

Restoration of the word "Torah" in Psalm 119

Strong's Concordance number #8451 translated into English as "law" in Psalms is actually "Torah" which means instructions not just "The Ten Commandments". Consider Hosea the prophet's statements regarding God's Torah:

"My people are destroyed for lack of knowledge: because thou hast rejected knowledge, I will also reject thee, that thou shalt be no priest to me: seeing thou hast forgotten the **law [Torah]** of thy God, I will also forget thy children." Hosea 4:6


Consider also 1 Peter 2:9:



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Note: Psalm 119 is in the exact center of the Bible and contains the longest chapter. The chapter deals with the Name and Authority of God and the Law/Torah He gave. The center three verses of Psalms 119 along with Ecclesiastics reveal the whole duty of man.

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"Let us hear the conclusion of the whole matter: Fear God, and keep his commandments: for this is the whole duty of man.
"For God shall bring every work into judgment, with every secret thing, whether it be good, or whether it be evil. " Ecclesiastes 12:13-14
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Judaism has largely forgot the Torah (Hosea 4:6) and superseded it with the Talmud. For 1,700 years Christianity has taught that obedience to the Torah is Legalism.

How have both of those positions worked out for the world?

Consider the examples below and what happens when you either change or discard major portions of the historical record of the Bible which is in direct violation of Biblical instructions found in both the Old and New Testaments in Deut. 4:1-2, 12:31-32; Matt.5:17-20, Rev. 22:14. Either the written Scriptures are authoritative, or they are not. Nearly the entire world has declared that they are not.

Modern Christian View of the TORAH

Two Interpretations of Galatians 4

Current disagreement over the interpretation of Gal. 4 has to do with whether Paul condemned the people because they observed the pagan customs, or because they observed Jewish customs. Based on the context of the situation, one of these interpretations is clearly incorrect. See Version 1 and 2 below.

Since Paul and the early Christians continued to observe the "Feasts of the LORD" after Christ's resurrection, it is <u>not</u> possible that he used the language he did, in Gal. 4:8-10, in referring to Leviticus 23.

I Am Afraid Of You

"Ye observe days, and months, and times, and years. I am afraid of you, lest I have bestowed upon you labour in vain."

Version 1: Galatians 4:8-10

4:8 Howbeit then, when ye knew not God [before learning of YHWH], ye did service unto them [pagan gods] which by nature are no gods [Astarte, Cybele, Isis, Jupiter, Mars, Moon, Stars, Sun, Zeus].

- 4:9 But now, after that ye have known God [LORD], or rather are known of God [LORD], how turn ye again to the <u>weak and beggarly elements</u> [ceremonial system], whereunto ye desire again to be in <u>bondage</u> [to the law]?
- 4:10 Ye observe days, and months, and times, and years [festivals of the Jewish religious calendar].
- 4:11 I am afraid *of* you [who are turning back to bondage of the Ceremonial Law], lest I have bestowed upon you labour in vain.

Figure 1 - Galatians 4 Diagram


Conclusion: The Galatians simply reverted back to observing the pagan holiday calendar, as the overwhelming majority of Christians do today. Paul was addressing that problem – an error which is now being corrected by the *Hebrew Roots Movement*.

"This set of visualizations started as a collaboration between Christoph Römhild and myself (Chris Harrison). Christoph, a Lutheran Pastor, first emailed me in October of 2007. He described a data set he was putting together that defined textual cross references found in the Bible. He had already done considerable work visualizing the data before contacting me. Together, we struggled to find an elegant solution to render the data, more than 63,000 cross references in total. As work progressed, it became clear that an interactive visualization would be needed to properly explore the data, where users could zoom in and prune down the information to manageable levels. However, this was less interesting to us, as several Bible-exploration programs existed that offered similar functionality (and much more). Instead we set our sights on the other end of the spectrum -- something more beautiful than functional. At the same time, we wanted something that honored and revealed the complexity of the data at every level -- as one leans in, smaller details should become visible. This ultimately led us to the multi-colored arc diagram you see below.

"The bar graph that runs along the bottom represents all of the chapters in the Bible. Books alternate in color between white and light gray. The length of each bar denotes the number of verses in the chapter. Each of the 63,779 cross references found in the Bible is depicted by a single arc - the color corresponds to the distance between the two chapters, creating a rainbow-like effect."
